## **Course Expectations:**

Students have the incredible opportunity to plan, participate and lead in corporate worship. Students have auditioned, signed a contract, and been chosen through prayer for this class and therefore, will be held to a higher standard because they are leaders. Students should strive to “present themselves to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth” (2 Timothy 2:15).

The students will learn through Bible/book study and daily vocal and instrumental practice. Students will be evaluated on participation and attitude towards responsibility, teammates, and their outward relationship with God. Honors students will maintain a journal and lead book study discussions on Wednesdays.

## **Technology**

All high school students are required to have a fully charged, fully functioning laptop in class each day. Students will be required to access Planning Center Online to learn and practice their music daily in class and at home.

## **Category Weights**

## **Class Expectations** (classroom rules/consequences)

## **Student Expectations**

- It is expected that every student will conduct himself in an honest manner, avoiding such actions as lying, stealing, and cheating.
- It is expected that every student will be on time to each class and be prepared with a proper mental attitude and all their necessary materials, books and assigned work.
- It is expected that every student understands that the teacher's desk, computer, and other personal belongings and work area is personal property and will be treated as such.

### **After School Expectations**

The majority of the class is held within school hours. However, there are a few exceptions.

- Operation Christmas Child Chapel (could be prior to school hours – dependent of the weather this year)
