



English 9 Honors – Summer Reading Assignment 2022

During the summer of 2022, students enrolled in English 9 Honors at SFCA are assigned to read ***Animal Farm*** by George Orwell. This allegorical fable was published in 1945 and explores the evils of totalitarianism. Students will be assigned a project and a test for this book.

Project requirement:

Students are to compose an exchange of letters between two characters in the book.

The letters should reflect a summary of the action over the course of the book, the characters' thoughts and reactions to these events, and the lessons Orwell is trying to communicate to the reader.

The letters are to be typed and formatted on one document, to be submitted on CANVAS through "Turn It In" by August 11, 2022.

There is to be a minimum of 10 letters of 100 words-minimum **each**. Letters are to be written using standard English grammar rules.

Test requirement:

Students will complete an objective test over the characters and content of the book. The test will be given on Friday, August 12, 2022.

Looking ahead:

Books for the remainder of the 2022-23 school year for English 9 Honors are listed below.

Quarter 1	<i>Journey to the Center of the Earth</i> by Jules Verne
Quarter 2	<i>Night</i> by Elie Wiesel
Quarter 3	<i>Of Mice and Men</i> by John Steinbeck
Quarter 4	Student-selected book

SFCA English Honors students are required to obtain their own copies of the assigned books. They may choose hard-copy or digital books. They will not be required to submit their personal copies of books; therefore, library loans are a potential source.
