RE-OPENING GUIDE

Your administrative team, faculty, and staff have been eagerly and prayerfully preparing for the 2020-2021 school year. This Re-Opening Guide has been developed to navigate us through the effective and safe return to campus on August 12 and will be updated as necessary. Though it is not an exhaustive list of all procedures and protocols that will be followed, it does provide an overview of important expectations and policies that will be in place as we begin the school year. Please note that these policies are intended to mitigate, not eliminate, risk.

OUR STRATEGY

As SFCA Administration prepares for on-campus school operations to resume in August, we will follow specific health precautions in accordance with local, state, and federal requirements. Specific decisions and plans regarding on-campus modifications will be finalized over the next several weeks. Implementation of the tier phases will be determined by local and state health officials in conjunction with the SFCA Administration.

This presentation contains the SFCA tiered phase re-opening plan that will be referred to throughout the 2020-2021 school year. **We anticipate to start the school year in Tier II of the re-opening guide.**

The SFCA Administration is preparing for possible waves of interruption to on-campus learning in the event our local community experiences a spike in COVID-19 cases. If an interruption of physical operations occurs, a shift to Tier III of the re-opening plan will occur and SFCA Virtual will happen immediately. This will only happen if the Florida government officials mandate a campus closure.

In the event of a government mandated campus closure and SFCA transitions to SFCA Virtual, families will be extended financial credit towards incidental fees.

<p>Nurse</p> <p>A full time School Nurse/ Student Health Director has been hired and a second clinic has been added on campus.</p>	<p>Masks/Face Shields/Bufs</p> <p>Only solid color or SFC A branded masks/face shields/buffs are allowed. SFC A branded items will be available for purchase in the school and athletic office starting 8/10/2020.</p>	<p>Drop Off/Pick Up</p> <p>Parents must remain in their vehicles during morning drop off and afternoon pick up.</p>
<p>Water Fountains</p> <p>Fountains will be replaced with bottle filling stations and water coolers equipped with UV lighting. Students will be required to carry their own water/refillable water bottles. Water bottles will be available for purchase during the school day.</p>	<p>Lunch</p> <p>Lunch will have staggered shifts to allow for more social distancing. Grab and Go options will be available as well as single serve condiments. Microwaves will not be available. Servers will wear appropriate PPE. Disinfection and sanitization will take place between lunch periods.</p>	<p>Parents/Visitors</p> <p>Only essential workers will be allowed in the school buildings. Volunteers will not be utilized on campus.</p>

Preparing for COVID Sickness

Prevent the Spread

- Self monitor for symptoms.
- Avoid travel to hot spot locations.
- Avoid close contact with an individual infected with COVID-19.
- Do not come to school and notify divisional principal if you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, are waiting for test results, are diagnosed with COVID-19, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19.

Exposure Protocol

- Symptomatic students will be sent to the school nurse and parents will be contacted.
- Local health officials, staff and families of cases of COVID-19 will be notified while maintaining appropriate confidentiality.
- Those who have had close contact with a person diagnosed with COVID-19 will be advised to stay home, self-monitor for symptoms, and follow CDC guidance if symptoms develop.
- Exposed areas will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected before further use.

Return to Campus

- Sick individuals will not be able to return to school until
 - At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared and
 - At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication and
 - Symptoms have improved.
