

## 4<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supplies for 2025-2026

Please make sure your student has the following school supplies ready for Back-to-School Orientation.

- **Zipped Trapper Keeper** Students switch classes this year, so they need a way to bring their belongings from class to class. Students may bring a backpack if needed, and we will provide a place to store them, but they will not be taking them to every class.
- 4 pocket folders placed in the Trapper Keeper and labeled: Bible, Math & Science (1 folder), History, and [Student Name]'s Friday Folder
- Pack of 5 tabbed dividers placed in the Trapper Keeper and labeled: Vocabulary, Writing, Spelling, Reading, and Grammar
- 1 pack of <u>wide-ruled</u> paper
- 2 packs of Ticonderoga pencils
- 3 wide-ruled composition notebooks with your student's name and labeled: ELA, Science, and Personal Use
- 1 5-subject notebook
- 1 pack of pencil cap erasers
- 1 pack of Colored Pencils or 1 pack of Crayons
- 1 pack of skinny or regular Crayola markers
- 1 pack of 3-count or 5-count glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors (appropriate for fourth grade)
- 3 boxes of tissues
- 1 pack of index cards (any color or white)
- 1 pack of 4-count Expo markers
- 1 pack of highlighters
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 1 box of band-aids
- Reusable water bottle labeled with your student's name to bring each day (we have bottle fillers, but students are responsible for bringing a bottle to refill we do not provide cups).
- **Girls:** 1 container of Clorox wipes and 1 box of quart-size Ziploc bags
- Boys: 1 large bottle of hand sanitizer and 1 box of gallon-size Ziploc bags
- For STEM Class (please label "STEM"):
  - **Boys:** 1 pack of straws
  - **Girls:** 1 pack of plastic spoons
- For Art Class (please label items "Art"):
  - o 2 fine tip black sharpies
  - 2 extra fine tip black sharpies
- For Innovation and Investigation Lab
  - 1 **yellow** plastic folder with prongs and pockets
